



CLINICAL GUIDELINES

“**Bell-Horn** braces are medical products registered with the FDA as a “medical device”.

Bell- Horn does not prescribe braces or determine the appropriateness of any particular bracing methodology for the individual. Medical advice should be sought on the appropriateness and the condition under which a given brace should be worn”.

Following is a general guide to clinical indications for each **Modular Spinal Therapy MST)** system from **Bell-Horn**:

- **Ortho Armor SI Belt – Indications:** SI joint pain
- **Ortho Armor SPINE Brace — Indications:** Lower back pain, spinal instability, early intervention & prevention
- **Ortho Armor Spine Brace Flex Power Plus – Indications:** Multiple level decompression, laminectomy, posterior lateral fusion
- **Ortho Armor Premium Plus – Indications:** Thoracolumbar injury, revision surgery, multi-level fusion
- **Ortho Armor CRUCIFORM – Indications:** Compression fractures, hyperkyphosis
- **Ortho Armor TRI-MOD System Plus – Indications:** Multiple level decompression, laminectomy, posterior lateral fusion, spondylolysis, spondylolisthesis, and mechanical back pain

NOTE: The above indications may serve as a basic guide. The utilization of all **Bell-Horn Modular Spinal Therapy** systems should not, however, be limited to the above criteria, but rather left to the judgment of qualified medical professionals, who have the responsibility for determining the therapeutic benefit and clinical utility of each specific type of back brace, for each particular patient.
